



The Easy Ribbed Scarf

Crochet Pattern

Materials

- **Hook** : 6.5 mm
- **Yarn** : Medium 4 weight
(Heathered Tweed by Loops & Threads was used to crochet the scarf pictured.) *Approx 150g.
- **Scissors**
- **Yarn Needle**

Stitch Legend

- *Rw* – row
- *st(s)* – stitch(es)
- *ch(s)* – chains(s)
- *sl st* – slip stitch
- *HDC* - half double crochet
- *BLO* – back loops only
- *FBL* - back bottom loops
- * - repeat



*The length of this scarf is 53" (135cm). I made this for a child but the length fits just fine on an adult. Of course you can create more length by adding more rows if you choose.

Pattern


Begin with a slip knot on your hook and ch 30 to begin.

R – 1

- 1 HDC into 2nd ch from the hook, continue placing 1 HDC into each st to the end of your row. You will have a **total of 29 sts** at the end of this round and every round from here on. Ch 1 and turn

R – 2


- place 1HDC into the front bottom loop (FBL) of the first st and into every st of the row.



This will push the top loops of the stitch forward on the 'right side' to create the ribbed effect. At the end of the row, ch 1 and turn.

Rnd – 3

- HDC in the back loop only (BLO) of each stitch across.



Ch 1 and turn.

*Repeat Row 2 & 3 until you reach Row 172 (or to your desired length) Do not snip your yarn.

Border

- ch 3 and turn your work sideways so that you are working down the side of your scarf.
- sl st into the side of the first row, then (ch 3 and sl st)* into the side of each row to create a scalloped edge.



- once you get to the bottom edge, continue as usual but since you will have actual stitches, just skip a stitch after each ch 3.

Do this all the way around the scarf until your border is complete. Then snip your yarn, fasten off and weave in your ends.

Voila! Your EASY RIBBED scarf is done!
